DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 10, 613 suspected dengue cases were reported in 24 districts in comparison to 542 cases in 25 districts during the week 09. There is a 13.0% increase in week 10, compared to the previous week. Of all cases 39.3% were reported from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 5.7%, Rest of the Colombo District – 14.4%, Gampaha District – 10.3% and Kalutara District – 9.0%] (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Forty one MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 10. Out of them, 17 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in week 10 compared to the week 09, and another 12 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 09 and 10 (Table 2).


In week 10 high risk level of Hanwella, Ja-Ela, Katana, Mahara, Bandaragama, Horana, MC Kandy, Uppuveli, Chilaw, MC Rathnapura and Badulla MOH areas have come down while Pitakotte, Biyagama, Gampaha, Kelaniya, Wadduwa, Akmeemana, Bope, Habaraduwa, Nallur, Alayadivembu, Puttalam, Kuliyapitiya and Mawanella MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 69 hospitals throughout the country was 225* and 226 during the weeks 09 and 10 respectively. In 20 hospitals, the average midnight total has decreased in the week 10 when compared with the previous week (Table 3).

*Average midnight total of the 09th week shows a decrease from 232 to 225 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
