DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 46, 1130 suspected dengue cases were reported in 24 districts in comparison to 933 cases in 23 districts during the week 45. There is a 21% increase in the week 46, compared to the previous week (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Forty-three MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during the week 46. Out of them, 18 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in the week 46 compared to the week 45, and 21 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 45 and 46 (Table 2).

In week 46 high risk level of Bandaragama, Poojapitiya and Maho MOH areas have come down while Kahathuduwa and Medadumbara MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.


MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 69 hospitals throughout the country was 377* and 439 during the week 45 and 46 respectively. In 16 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased in the week 46 when compared with the previous week.

DGH Negombo, National Hospital of Sri Lanka, Colombo South Teaching Hospital, PGH Badulla, National Institute of Infectious Diseases, and Colombo North Teaching Hospital have reported the highest number of admissions (Table 3).

*Average midnight total of the 45th week shows an increase from 333 to 377 when compared to the previous week's report due to delay in data reporting.
