

WEEKLY DENGUE UPDATE

13th December 2021—19th December 2021 National Dengue Control Unit, Ministry of Health



DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 50, 2255 suspected dengue cases were reported in 26 districts in comparison to 1806 cases in 25 districts during the week 49. There is a 24.9% increase in the week 50, compared to the previous week. Of all cases 66.2% were reported from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 11.1%, Rest of the Colombo District – 21.3%, Gampaha District – 24.7% and Kalutara District – 9.1%] (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS


Seventy one MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during the week 50. Out of them, 39 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in the week 50 compared to the week 49, and another 28 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 49 and 50 (Table 2). In week 50 high risk level of Medadumbara, Udunuwara, Tangalle, MC Matara, Ampara, Seruwila, Mawathagama, Mallawapitiya, Soranathota, Monaragala, Imbulpe, Kegalle and Ruwanwella MOH areas have come down while Hanwella, Egoda Uyana, Divulapitiya, Wattegama, Balapitiya, Kopay, Karaveddy, Pannala, Dankotuwa, Puttalam, Eheliyagoda, Embilipitiya and Godakawela MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 69 hospitals throughout the country was 775* and 885 during the week 49 and 50 respectively. In 27 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased in the week 50 when compared with the previous week (Table 3).

*Average midnight total of the 49th week shows a decrease from 776 to 775 when compared to the previous week's report after updating with delayed reports.
