DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 21, 1616 suspected dengue cases were reported in 26 districts in comparison to 1576 cases in 24 districts during the week 20. There is a 2.5% increase in week 21, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases 55.0% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 10.5%, Rest of the Colombo District – 23.4%, Gampaha District – 11.6% and Kalutara District – 9.4%]. Kandy [6.8%], Hambantota [5.1%], Galle [4.6%], and Jaffna [4.6%], districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Seventy one MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 21. Out of them, 18 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in week 21 compared to the week 20, and another 51 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 20 and 21 (Table 2).


In week 21 high risk level of Seeduwa, Kundasale, Bope Poddala, Uduvil, Chankanai, Sandilipay, Trincomalee, Uppuveli, Trincomalee (Naval Base), Koralai Pattu Central, Akkaraipattu, Kalmunai South, Puttalam, Wennappuwa, Nikaweratiya, Pannala, Godakawela, MC Rathnapura, Udawalawa, Deraniyagala, Kegalle, and Ruwanwella MOH areas have come down while Kahathuduwa, Minuwangoda, Ukuwela, MC Matale, Balapitiya, Tangalle, Walasmulla, Weligama, Point Pedro, Chenkalady and Pelmadulla MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 69 hospitals throughout the country was 557* and 605 during the weeks 20 and 21 respectively. In 23 hospitals, the average midnight total has decreased in the week 21 when compared with the previous week (Table 3).

*Average midnight total of the 20th week shows an increase from 551 to 557 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
