DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 42, 997 suspected dengue cases were reported in 25 districts in comparison to 1178 cases in 24 districts during the week 41. There is a 15.4% decrease in week 42, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases 48.2% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 4.0%, Rest of the Colombo District – 13.1%, Gampaha District – 23.3% and Kalutara District – 7.8%]. Kandy [9.7%], Puttalam [5.4%], Jaffna [5.2%], and Kegalle [4.6%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Thirty-one MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 42. Out of them, 09 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in week 42 compared to the week 41, and another 19 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 42 and 41 (Table 2).


In week 42 high risk levels of Piliyandala, Battaramulla, MC Negombo, Gangawatakorale, Yatinuwara, Akuressa, Akkaraipattu, Mahawewa, Badulla and Eheliyagoda MOH areas have come down while Moratuwa, Dompe, Ragama, Beruwala (NIHS), Gampola, Waththegama, MC Matale, Weligama, MC Jaffna and Ruwanwella MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 73 hospitals throughout the country was 417 and 387 during the weeks 41 and 42 respectively. In 33 hospitals, the average midnight total has decreased in the week 42 when compared with the previous week (Table 3).

*Average midnight total of the 41st week shows a decrease from 421 to 417 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
