DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 47, 1406 suspected dengue cases were reported in 24 districts in comparison to 1314 cases in 26 districts during the week 46. There is an 7.0% increase in week 47, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases 45.0% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 4.5%, Rest of the Colombo District – 12.4%, Gampaha District – 21.8% and Kalutara District – 6.2%]. Puttalam [11.1%], Kandy [8.5%], Jaffna [6.9%] and Kalmunai [4.4%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Fifty MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 47. Out of them, 15 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in week 47 compared to the week 46, and another 29 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 47 and 46 (Table 2).


In week 47 high risk levels of Piliyandala and Moratuwa MOH areas have come down while Dehiwala, Maharagama, Nugegoda, Battaramulla, Mirigama, Beruwala (NIHS), Gampola, Gangawatakorale, Naula, Ukuwela, Kopay, Thellippilai, Sandilipay, Kuliyapitiya, Dankotuwa, Puttalam and Alayadivembu MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 73 hospitals throughout the country was 517 and 564 during the weeks 46 and 47 respectively. In 19 hospitals, the average midnight total has decreased and in 33 hospitals the average mid night total has increased in the week 47 when compared with the previous week. Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of admissions in the week 47 are displayed in Table 3.

*Average midnight total of the 46th week shows an increase from 500 to 517 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
