

# WEEKLY DENGUE UPDATE

14<sup>th</sup> October 2022 – 20<sup>th</sup> November 2022 National Dengue Control Unit, Ministry of Health

### **DENGUE CASE REPORTING**

During the week 46, 1314 suspected dengue cases were reported in 26 districts in comparison to 1053 cases in 25 districts during the week 45. There is an 24.8% increase in week 46, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases 43.8% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 4.2%, Rest of the Colombo District – 10.2%, Gampaha District – 24.8% and Kalutara District – 4.6%]. Kandy [8.2%], Puttalam [7.5%], Jaffna [5.9%] and Rathnapura [5.3%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

### **HIGH RISK MOH AREAS**

Thirty- five MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 46. Out of them, 19 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in week 46 compared to the week 45, and another 15 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 46 and 45 (Table 2).

In week 46 high risk levels of Maharagama, Beruwala (NIHS), Yatinuwara, Karandeniya, Puttalam and Warakapola MOH areas have come down while Piliyandala, Moratuwa, Gothatuwa, Biyagama, Katana, Mahara, Kalutara (NIHS), Wattegama, MC Matale, Nallur, Karaveddy, Mahawewa, Kuruvita, Dehiovita and Addalaichenai MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

#### MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 73 hospitals throughout the country was 451 and 500 during the weeks 45 and 46 respectively. In 13 hospitals, the average midnight total has decreased and in 23 hospitals the average mid night total has increased in the week 35 when compared with the previous week. Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of admissions in the week 46 are displayed in Table 3.

\*Average midnight total of the 45<sup>th</sup> week shows a decrease from 454 to 451 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.

# WEEKLY DISTRIBUTION OF DENGUE PATIENTS in 2021 and 2022


