## **DENGUE CASE REPORTING**

During the week 04, 1944 suspected dengue cases were reported in 23 districts in comparison to 2032 cases in 26 districts during the week 03. There is a 4.3% decrease in week 04, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases 51.4% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 4.6%, Rest of the Colombo District – 17.3%, Gampaha District – 22.9% and Kalutara District – 6.6%]. Puttalam [9.8%], Kalmunai [5.6%], Kandy [4.5%], Jaffna [4.2%] and Kurunegala [4.1%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

#### **HIGH RISK MOH AREAS**

Fifty-nine MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 04. Out of them, 07 MOH areas showed a rising number of cases in week 04 compared to the week 03, and another 50 MOH areas showed persistently high number of cases in both weeks 04 and 03 (Table 2).


In week 04 high risk levels of Akuressa, Nallur, Kalmunai North, Anamaduwa, Mundel, Mahawewa and Kegalle MOH areas have come down while Pitakotte, Boralesgamuwa, Sandilipay, Uppuveli, Kurunegala, Arachchikattuwa, Embilipitiya, Kuruwita and Yatiyantota MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

### **MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS**

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 75 hospitals throughout the country was 702 and 679 during the weeks 03 and 04 respectively. In 20 hospitals, the average midnight total has decreased and in 26 hospitals the average mid night total has increased in the week 04 when compared with the previous week. Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of admissions in the week 04 are displayed in Table 3.

\*Average midnight total of the 03<sup>rd</sup> week shows a decrease from 706 to 702 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
