DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 18, 1954 suspected dengue cases were reported in 25 districts in comparison to 1896 cases in 26 districts during the week 17. There is a 3.0% increase in week 18, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases 51.7% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council - 4.1%, Rest of the Colombo District – 16.9%, Gampaha District -24.3% and Kalutara District – 6.3%]. Kandy [7.0%], Batticaloa [5.4%], Trincomalee [5.5%], and Kegalle [4.1%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Fifty-nine MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 18. Out of them, 19 MOH areas showed a rising number of cases in week 18 compared to the week 17, and another 40 MOH areas showed persistently high number of cases in both weeks 18 and 17 (Table 2).


In week 18, high risk levels of Wadduwa, Udunuwara, Wattegama, Akuressa, Walasmulla, Uduvil, Oddamavadai, Puttalam, Badulla, Kuruwita, Ruwanwella and Kalmunai South MOH areas have come down. Kolonnawa, Pitakotte, Minuwangoda, Mirigama, Ingiriya, Gampola, Gangawatakorale, Talatuoya, Yatinuwara, Karaveddy, Pannala, Arachchikattuwa, Dehiowita, Kegalle, Mawanella, Rambukkana and Akkaraipattu MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 73 hospitals throughout the country was 694 and 725 during the weeks 17 and 18 respectively. In 35 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 14 hospitals the average mid night total has decreased in the week 18 when compared with the previous week. Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the week 18 are displayed in Table 3.

*Average midnight total of the 18th week shows an increase from 675 to 694 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
