## **DENGUE CASE REPORTING**

During the week 21, 2289 suspected dengue cases were reported in 26 districts in comparison to 2215 cases in 26 districts during the week 20. There is a 3.3% increase in week 21, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases 51.5% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council -4.6%, Rest of the Colombo District – 17.8%, Gampaha District -20.5% and Kalutara District – 8.6%]. Kandy [9.9%], Rathnapura [4.4%], Kurunegala [4.1%], Galle [4.1%], Kegalle [3.7%] and Batticaloa [3.7%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

#### **HIGH RISK MOH AREAS**

Sixty MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 21. Out of them, 24 MOH areas showed a rising number of cases in week 21 compared to the week 20, and another 36 MOH areas showed persistently high number of cases in both weeks 21 and 20 (Table 2).

In week 21, high risk levels of Mirigama, Horana, Wadduwa, Kundasale, Poojapitiya, Rathgama, Walasmulla, Kuchchaveli, Thamankaduwa, Embilipitiya, Kuruwita, Kegalle, Mawanella and Warakapola MOH areas have come down. Egoda Uyana, Mathugama, Doluwa, MC Matale, MC Galle, Korali Pattu (Central), Kurunegala, Polgahawela, Kekirawa, Godakawela, MC Ratnapura, Aranayaka and Ruwanwella MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

# MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 73 hospitals throughout the country was 767 and 868 during the weeks 20 and 21 respectively. In 33 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 22 hospitals the average mid night total has decreased in the week 21 when compared with the previous week. Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the week 21 are displayed in Table 3.

\*Average midnight total of the 20<sup>th</sup> week shows a decrease from 768 to 767 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
