DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 23, 2730 suspected dengue cases were reported in 26 districts in comparison to 2396 cases in 26 districts during the week 22. There is a 13.9% increase in week 23, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases 54.6% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council -4.7%, Rest of the Colombo District – 21.2%, Gampaha District -21.3% and Kalutara District –7.4%]. Kandy [9.6%], Rathnapura [5.0%], Kurunegala [4.6%] and Kegalle [3.4%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Sixty-seven MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 23. Out of them, 21 MOH areas showed a rising number of cases in week 23 compared to the week 22, and another 46 MOH areas showed persistently high number of cases in both weeks 23 and 22 (Table 2).

In week 23, high risk levels of Kahathuduwa, Sooriyawewa, Okewela, Mullaitivu, Pannala, MC Ratnapura, Ruwanwella, Warakapola, Yatiyantota and Bulathkohupitiya MOH areas have come down. Pitakotte, Kurunduwatta, Wattegama, Balapitiya, Chenkalady, Ibbagamuwa, Kuliyapitiya, MC Kurunegala, Kalpitiya, Embilipitiya, Galigamuwa and Mawanella MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 73 hospitals throughout the country was 937 and 915 during the weeks 22 and 23 respectively. In 23 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 30 hospitals the average mid night total has decreased in the week 23 when compared with the previous week. Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the week 23 are displayed in Table 3.

*Average midnight total of the 22nd week shows a decrease from 951 to 937 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.
