

DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During 4th week, 1976 suspected dengue cases were reported in 25 districts in comparison to 2277, in 26 districts during the 3rd week. There is 13.2% decrease in 4th week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 34.2% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 10.0%, rest of the Colombo District – 14.4 %, Gampaha District – 5.9% and Kalutara District – 3.8%]. Jaffna [25.9%], Kandy [8.5%], Galle [7.3%], Rathnapura [3.6%], Kurunegala [3.0%] and Kegalle [3.0%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During 4^{th} week, 44 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk. Of them, 7 MOH areas showed rising numbers than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 40 MOH areas in both 3^{rd} and 4^{th} weeks.

The MOH areas that were newly flagged as high-risk areas in 4th week are Minuwangoda, Pugoda, Addalaichchenai and Gangawatakorale. The MOH areas that were flagged as highrisk in 3rd week and not flagged for the current week are; Udunuwara, Waththegama, Harispattuwa, Muttur, Alayadivembu, Kalmunai North, Kurunegala, Alawwa, Kayts, Velanai, Kilinochchi, Warakapola, Homagama, Moratuwa, Attanagalla, Mirigama, Bope Poddala, Hikkaduwa and Badulla.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 3rd week shows a decrease from 784 to 783.

In 4th week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 708. In 16 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 34 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the 4^{th} week are illustrated in Table 3.
