

DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During 20th week, 770 suspected dengue cases were reported in 22 districts in comparison to 523, in 25 districts during the 19th week. There is 47.2% increase in 20th week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 36.4% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 4.9%, rest of the Colombo District – 16.6%, Gampaha District – 10.5% and Kalutara District – 4.3%]. Ratnapura [19.2%], Kandy [11.2%], Kurunegala [7.8%], Kegalle [7.0%] and Galle [4.0%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During 20th week, 9 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk. Of them 6 MOH areas showed rising number than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 7 MOH areas in both 19th and 20th weeks.

Kelaniya MOH area was newly flagged as high-risk areas in the 20^{th} week. Warakapola MOH area which was flagged as high-risk in the 19^{th} week was not flagged in the current week.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 19th week shows an increase from 243 to 245.

In the 20th week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 256. In 18 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 20 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the 20^{th} week are illustrated in Table 3.

KEY ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED DURING WEEK 20 AT NATIONAL LEVEL

- Comprehensive review of the national dengue control programme with WHO technical and financial support was carried out from 13th to 20th May 2024.
- Continued close monitoring of disease trend at MOH division level is ongoing.
- A Special Mosquito Control Week is planned on 17 districts, targeting 71 high-risk MOH areas from 26th May to 1st of June.
