WEEKLY DENGUE UPDATE

DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During 37^{th} week, 711 suspected dengue cases were reported in 24 districts in comparison to 649 in 24 districts during the 36^{th} week. There is 9.6% increase in 37^{th} week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 54.0% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 6.8%, rest of the Colombo District – 25.9%, Gampaha District – 16.2% and Kalutara District – 5.2%]. Kandy [9.3%], Galle [5.9%], Ratnapura [4.4%], Matara [4.2%], Kegalle [3.1%], and Kurunegala [3.5%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During 37th week, 9 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk. Of them 2 MOH areas showed rising number than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 8 MOH areas in both 36th and 37th weeks.

Gothatuwa and Kahathuduwa newly flagged as high-risk MOH areas in the 37th week. Battaramulla, Homagama and Seeduwa MOH areas flagged as high-risk in the 37th week, were not flagged in the current week.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 36th week shows an increase from 234 to 235.

In the 37th week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 224. In 22 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 21 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the 37^{th} week are illustrated in Table 3.


