DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 12, 798 suspected dengue cases were reported in 25 districts in comparison to 733 cases in 24 districts during the week 11. There is an 8.9% increase in week 12, compared to the previous week. Of all cases 39.8% were reported from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 4.5%, Rest of the Colombo District – 14.5%, Gampaha District – 9.9% and Kalutara District – 10.9%] while 10.2% were from Galle District (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Fifty-five MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 12. Out of them, 20 MOH areas showed rising number of cases in week 12 compared to the week 11, and another 6 MOH areas show persistently high number of cases in both weeks 11 and 12 (Table 2).

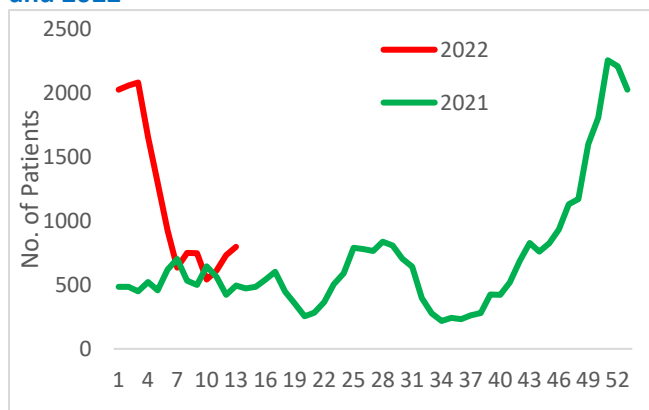
In week 12 high risk level of Kahathuduwa, Egoda Uyana, Ja-Ela, Dompe, Mahara, MC Matara, Kopay, Akkarai pattu, Chilaw and Embilipitiya areas have come down while Pitakotte, Hanwella, Minuwangoda, Ragama, Wattala, Seeduwa, MC Kandy, Baddegama, Balapitiya, Point Pedro, Trincomalee, Trincomalee (naval base), Koralai Pattu Central, Kalpitiya, Pelmadulla, Elapatha, Mawanella and Badulla MOH Areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 69 hospitals throughout the country was 258* and 235 during the weeks 11 and 12 respectively. In 27 hospitals, the average midnight total has decreased in the week 12 when compared with the previous week (Table 3).

**Average midnight total of the 11th week shows an increase from 249 to 258 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.*
