## DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During the week 03, 2032 suspected dengue cases were reported in 26 districts in comparison to 2030 cases in 26 districts during the week 02. There is a 0.1% increase in week 03, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases 46.3% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 6.1%, Rest of the Colombo District – 13.3%, Gampaha District – 21.5% and Kalutara District – 5.4%]. Puttalam [14.5%], Kalmunai [8.0%], Jaffna [4.2%] and Kegalle [3.7%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

## HIGH RISK MOH AREAS

Fifty-seven MOH areas were flagged as high-risk areas during week 03. Out of them, 14 MOH areas showed a rising number of cases in week 03 compared to the week 02, and another 42 MOH areas showed persistently high number of cases in both weeks 03 and 02 (Table 2).

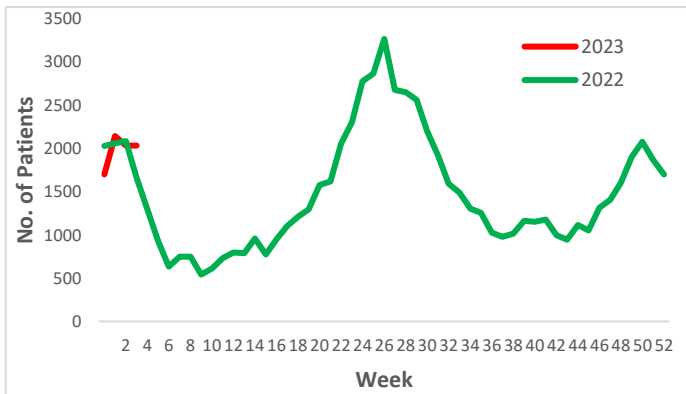
In week 03 high risk levels of Mirigama, Bandaragama, Harispattuwa, Chavakachcheri, Kopay, Karaveddy, Mannar, Dehiovita and Kurunegala MOH areas have come down while Akuressa, Batticaloa, Eravur, Trincomalee, Madampe, Badulla, Eheliyagoda, Kegalle, Kalmunai North and Alayadivembu MOH areas were newly identified as high-risk areas.

## MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

Average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 75 hospitals throughout the country was 725 and 706 during the weeks 02 and 03 respectively. In 25 hospitals, the average midnight total has decreased and in 22 hospitals the average mid night total has increased in the week 03 when compared with the previous week. Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of admissions in the week 03 are displayed in Table 3.

*\*Average midnight total of the 02<sup>nd</sup> week shows a decrease from 732 to 725 when compared to the previous week's report after updated with delayed reporting from hospitals.*
