

## DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During 13<sup>th</sup> week, 628 suspected dengue cases were reported in 25 districts in comparison to 666, in 24 districts during the 12<sup>th</sup> week. There is 5.7% decrease in 13<sup>th</sup> week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 44.3% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 4.8%, rest of the Colombo District – 17.2%, Gampaha District – 11.6% and Kalutara District – 10.7%]. Jaffna [7.6%], Kandy [6.7%], Kegalle [5.6%], Ratnapura [4.8%], Galle [4.6%] and Batticaloa [4.1%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

## HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During 13<sup>th</sup> week, 2 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk. Of them, Kelaniya MOH area showed rising number than it's respective number in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in CMC area in both 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> weeks.

The Kelaniya MOH area was newly flagged as high-risk areas in 13<sup>th</sup> week. The MOH areas that were flagged as high-risk in 12<sup>th</sup> week and not flagged for the current week are Kesbawa, Kaduwela, Maharagama, Biyagama, Gampaha, Wattala, Kurunegala and Chavakachcheri.

## MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

\* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 12<sup>th</sup> week shows an increase from 268 to 284.

In 13<sup>th</sup> week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 260. In 15 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 27 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the 13<sup>th</sup> week are illustrated in Table 3.
