### **DENGUE CASE REPORTING**

During 35th week, 553 suspected dengue cases were reported in 23 districts in comparison to 583 in 25 districts during the 34th week. There is 4.8% decrease in 35th week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 39.8% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 3.6%, rest of the Colombo District - 18.2%, Gampaha District - 12.4% and Kalutara District – 5.6%]. Kandy [13.0%], Rathnapura [13.0%], Galle [6.7%], Matara [3.4%], and Matale [3.4%] districts also have reported higher proportions of cases (Table

#### **HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)**

During the 35th week, 3 MOH areas (Gothatuwa, Kuruvita, and Pelmadulla) were flagged as high-risk. All three MOH areas showed a rising number compared to their respective numbers in the previous week.

Kuruvita and Pelmadulla were newly flagged as high-risk MOH areas in the 35th week. CMC D3, Panadura, Kandy MC, Nivithigala, and MC Rathnapura areas, which were flagged as high-risk in the 34th week, were not flagged in the current week.

## MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

\* After being updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, the average midnight total for the 34th week shows an increase from 187 to 188.

In the 35th week, the average midnight total of dengue patients in the selected 74 hospitals was 178. In 13 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased, and in 17 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and a changing trend of dengue admissions in the 35th week are illustrated in Table 3.
