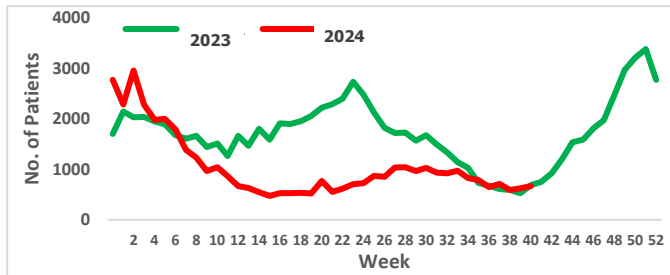

## DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During 40<sup>th</sup> week, 663 suspected dengue cases were reported in 25 districts in comparison to 624 in 23 districts during the 39<sup>th</sup> week. There is 6.3% increase in 40<sup>th</sup> week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 49.5% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 7.5%, rest of the Colombo District – 17.8%, Gampaha District – 17.0% and Kalutara District – 7.1%]. Kandy [8.0%], Ratnapura [6.6%], Matara [6.5%], Monaragala [5.0%] and Galle [4.1%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

## HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During 40<sup>th</sup> week, 12 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk. Of them 8 MOH areas showed rising number than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 7 MOH areas in both 39<sup>th</sup> and 40<sup>th</sup> weeks.

Kahathuduwa, Attanagalla, Mahara and Negombo newly flagged as high-risk MOH areas in the 40<sup>th</sup> week. Siyambalanduwa, Homagama and Kolonnawa MOH areas flagged as high-risk in the 39<sup>th</sup> week, were not flagged in the current week.

## MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

\* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 39<sup>th</sup> week shows an increase from 214 to 218.

In the 40<sup>th</sup> week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 248. In 24 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 21 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the 40<sup>th</sup> week are illustrated in Table 3.
