

DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During 43^{rd} week, 675 suspected dengue cases were reported in 22 districts in comparison to 627 in 24 districts during the 42^{nd} week. There is 7.7% increase in 43^{rd} week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 46.7% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council - 8.1%, rest of the Colombo District - 17.8%, Gampaha District - 14.4% and Kalutara District - 6.4%]. Kandy [8.9%], Ratnapura [7.9%], Monaragala [5.8%], Matale [5.0%], Matara [3.7%] and Galle [3.6%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During 42nd week, 8 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk. Of them 6 MOH areas showed rising number than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 4 MOH areas in both 42nd and 43rd weeks.

Rathnapura, Gothatuwa, Kesbewa and Wattala newly flagged as high-risk MOH areas in the 43rd week. Wennappuwa, Yatinuwara and Ragama MOH areas flagged as high-risk in the 42nd week, were not flagged in the current week.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 42nd week shows a decrease from 206 to 205.

In the 43rd week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 227. In 21 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 15 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the 43rd week are illustrated in Table 3.
