DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During 44th week, 672 suspected dengue cases were reported in 23 districts in comparison to 675 in 22 districts during the 43^{rd} week. There is 0.4% decrease in 44th week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 43.9% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 7.3%, rest of the Colombo District – 13.2%, Gampaha District – 18.0% and Kalutara District – 5.4%]. Kandy [10.0%], Galle [8.0%], Ratnapura [7.9%], Matale [4.9%], and Puttalam [4.3%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During 44th week, 10 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk. Of them 7 MOH areas showed rising number than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 6 MOH areas in both 43rd and 44th weeks.

Jaffna, Bope Poddala, Maharagama and Mahara newly flagged as high-risk MOH areas in the 44th week. Gothatuwa and Kesbewa MOH areas flagged as high-risk in the 43rd week, were not flagged in the current week.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 43rd week shows a decrease from 227 to 222.

In the 44th week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 225. In 21 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 17 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the 44^{th} week are illustrated in Table 3.


