

DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During 46th week, 701 suspected dengue cases were reported in 23 districts in comparison to 667 in 24 districts during the 44th week. There is 5.1% increase in 46th week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 49.2% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 12.0%, rest of the Colombo District – 16.3%, Gampaha District – 17.3% and Kalutara District – 3.7%]. Kandy [7.7%], Ratnapura [6.0%], Puttalam [5.7%], Galle [3.9%], and Monaragala [3.9%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During 46th week, 12 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk. Of them 7 MOH areas showed rising number than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 7 MOH areas in both 45th and 46th weeks.

MC Kandy, MC Matale, Jaffna, MC Galle, Homagama and Mahara newly flagged as high-risk MOH areas in the 46th week. Rathnapura, Maharagama and Ja-Ela MOH areas flagged as high-risk in the 45th week, were not flagged in the current week.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 45th week shows an increase from 250 to 254.

In the 46th week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 266. In 20 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 11 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the 46^{th} week are illustrated in Table 3.


