DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During 47th week, 880 suspected dengue cases were reported in 23 districts in comparison to 701 in 23 districts during the 46th week. There is 25.5% increase in 47th week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 44.9% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 8.5%, rest of the Colombo District – 15.2%, Gampaha District – 17.2% and Kalutara District – 4.0%]. Kandy [9.1%], Ratnapura [6.6%], Monaragala [6.6%], Galle [5.8%], and Jaffna [3.9%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During 47^{th} week, 20 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk. Of them 14 MOH areas showed rising number than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 10 MOH areas in both 46^{th} and 47^{th} weeks.

Kalpitiya, Kopay, Mawanella, Rathnapura MC, Madulla, Kaduwela, Kolonnawa, Maharagama, Rathmalana and Negombo newly flagged as high-risk MOH areas in the 47th week. Kelaniya and Jaffna MOH areas flagged as high-risk in the 46th week, were not flagged in the current week.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 46th week shows an increase from 266 to 270.

In the 47th week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 280. In 21 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 20 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the 47th week are illustrated in Table 3.
