

DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During 49th week, 778 suspected dengue cases were reported in 25 districts in comparison to 727 in 24 districts during the 48th week. There is 7.0% increase in 49th week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 45.8% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 8.5%, rest of the Colombo District – 19.3%, Gampaha District – 14.9% and Kalutara District – 3.1%]. Kandy [8.4%], Galle [5.4%], Jaffna [5.0%], Matale [4.5%], Ratnapura [4.5%], Anuradhapura [4.2%], and Batticaloa [4.0%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During 49^{th} week, 13 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk. Of them 10 MOH areas showed rising number than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 8 MOH areas in both 48^{th} and 49^{th} weeks.

Dehiwala, Gothatuwa, Ratmalana and Mahara newly flagged as high-risk MOH areas in the 49th week. Rattota, Jaffna, Kalpitiya and Biyagama areas flagged as high-risk in the 49th week, were not flagged in the current week.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 48th week shows decrease from 268 to 267.

In the 49th week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 267. In 17 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 17 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the 49th week are illustrated in Table 3.
