

DENGUE CASE REPORTING

During 50th week, 906 suspected dengue cases were reported in 24 districts in comparison to 778 in 25 districts during the 49th week. There is 16.5% increase in 50th week, compared to the previous week. Of all reported cases, 48.7% were from Western Province [Colombo Municipal Council – 9.3%, rest of the Colombo District – 19.1%, Gampaha District – 15.2% and Kalutara District – 5.1%]. Kandy [7.0%], Jaffna [5.6%], Galle [5.5%], Ratnapura [5.3%], Puttalam [4.0%], and Batticaloa [3.8%] districts also have reported higher number of cases (Table 1).

HIGH RISK MOH AREAS (Table 2)

During 50th week, 15 MOH areas were flagged as high-risk. Of them 9 MOH areas showed rising number than their respective numbers in previous week. Persistently high number of patients are observed in 11 MOH areas in both 49th and 50th weeks.

Oddamavadi, Kalpitiya, Chankanai and Siyambalanduwa newly flagged as high-risk MOH areas in the 50th week. Mahara MOH area flagged as high-risk in the 49th week, were not flagged in the current week.

MIDNIGHT TOTAL OF DENGUE PATIENT ADMISSIONS

* After updated with delayed reporting from hospitals, average midnight total for the 49th week shows a decrease from 267 to 265.

In the 50th week average midnight total of dengue patients in selected 74 hospitals was 307. In 27 hospitals, the average midnight total has increased and in 15 hospitals it has decreased compared to the previous week.

Selected hospitals with high average midnight totals of dengue patients and changing trend of dengue admissions in the 50th week are illustrated in Table 3.
